- 1) What is Jesus' question in John 21:15?
- 2) Did Peter answer the question?
- **3)** How does Jesus' question change in 21:16?
- **4)** John 21:17 records that Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him a third time, "Do you love me?" Why might Peter be "hurt" by Jesus' questions?
- **5)** In John 21:17 Peter declares, "Lord, you know all things". Since Jesus knows all things, including the answer to these questions, why might Jesus be asking Peter these questions?
- **6)** How might Jesus' questions about loving Him be connected to the subsequent calls to, "Feed my lambs", "Take care of my sheep", and "Feed my sheep"?
- 7) Take a moment to read John 21:18-19
  - Why might Jesus have told Peter ahead of time of his death?
  - In what ways can a person's death glorify God?
- 8) John 21:19 ends with a call, what is it?
- **9)** Given that Christ will ascend into heaven, how might following Christ look different than the manner in which Peter had followed Christ up to that point? How might it be the same?
- 10) In John 21: 20-22 Peter asks about another disciple
  - What does Peter ask?
  - How does Jesus respond?
  - What should Peter take from Christ's response?
  - What rumor spread as a result of Jesus' comment regarding John?
  - At the end of John 21:22, Jesus reiterates a call to Peter, what is it?
- **11)** Today, what does it mean to follow Jesus? Does it mean following His teachings? Following His example? Something different? Something more? How would you explain it?
- **12)** What is one step you could take to more fully follow Jesus?
