

Life Group Questions for 6.14.20

- 1) This Sunday our topic was worshipping God in spite of our circumstances. Is it easier to praise God when life goes well, or when life is hard? Why?
- 2) What prompts you to worship God?
- 3) Take a moment to read 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18.
 - What activities does this verse call believers to engage in?
 - This passage uses the word "always," "continually" and "all". What should we take away from these words?
 - How can a person "always" be joyful? What would be the basis for that joy?
 - How can a person give thanks in all circumstances? What would be the basis for that thankfulness?
 - How is God teaching you to be thankful in all things?
- 4) Take a moment to read Habakkuk 3:17-18.
 - Given the conditions described in verses 17, how can this person rejoice in the Lord?
 - What does it mean to rejoice "in the Lord"?
 - What does it mean to be joyful "in God my Savior"?
- 5) Read Job 1:13-22.
 - What was Job's response to tragic news?
 - What was Job's declaration in verse 21?
 - What does Job's words acknowledge?
- 6) What can you take away from this week's study?
