

## Life Group Questions for 11-1-20

- 1) Take a moment to read Matthew chapter 28.
- 2) How many times is the word “go” used in the Matthew 28?
- 3) Matthew 28:17 describes the response of the disciples.
  - a) What two responses are recorded?
  - b) In the context of this passage, what are they doubting?
  - c) Can someone worship and still doubt?
  - d) Can you share a time you struggled with doubt?
- 4) Jesus makes a declaration in Matthew 28:18
  - a) What is the declaration?
  - b) How is Matthew 28:18 connected to Colossians 1:13-20
  - c) What is the connection between Matthew 28:18 and 19? Why does being given all authority in verse 18, result in the “therefore” of verse 19?
- 5) Matthew 28:19 is a call to “go”.
  - a) Where are they to go?
  - b) As they go, what are they do?
  - c) How can you tell if someone is becoming a disciple?
- 6) Matthew 28:19 includes a call to teach people to obey Christ.
  - a) How many of Christ’s commands are we to obey?
  - b) What’s a command of Christ that people may find easier to obey?
  - c) What’s a command of Christ that people may find more difficult to obey?
  - d) Looking back, how have you learned to obey Christ?
  - e) Right now, what is God teaching you to obey?
- 7) Matthew 28:19 ends with a promise.
  - a) What is the promise?
  - b) In what way is Christ “with” us always?
  - c) How should this promise comfort us?
  - d) How should this promise motivate us?
- 8) What’s one step you can take to grow as a disciple of Christ?
- 9) What’s one way you can help make a disciple?
