- 2) 1 Corinthians 15:1 says "I want to remind you of the gospel".
  - A) Why might someone need to be reminded of the gospel?
  - B) What benefit is there in being reminded of the gospel?
- 3) How does a person take a "stand" on the gospel?
- 4) How does the gospel save us?
- 5) How does a person "hold firmly" to the word?
- 6) What does it mean to believe "in vain"?
- 7) According to 1 Corinthians 1:3, what did Paul do with that which he received?
- 8) According to 1 Corinthians 1:3-4, what is the gospel?
- 9) 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 repeats the phrase "according to the Scriptures" Why is this phrase important?
- 10) 1 Corinthians 15:5-7 reports people to whom the risen Christ appeared?
  - A) Why is this important?
  - B) What does Acts 1:3 say about Christ appearances after His resurrection?
  - C) What criteria was used for selecting a replacement for Judas in Acts 1:21-22?
- 11) Take a moment to read 1 Corinthians 15:10.
  - A) What effect did God's grace have on Paul?
  - B) Was it Paul that worked harder? Or God's grace that worked harder?
- 12) Do you have any other questions or comments on this week's passage?
- 13) How can you put this passage into practice this week?
