Getting Started

This week our topic is “Jesus is the Savior of the World”. How did you first learn that Jesus was the Savior?

Digging Deeper

- 1) In John 4:42, Jesus is described as “the Savior of the World”. In what ways does Jesus save us?
- 2) In Matthew 8:25, a storm is raging and the disciples cry out, “Lord save us”. In what way were they asking to be saved?
- 3) Can you think of other stories in the gospels where Jesus saves someone?
- 4) Take a moment to read 1 Timothy 4:10.
 - A) Who is God the Savior of?
 - B) What does it mean when it says “especially of those who believe”?
- 5) What does 2 Timothy 1:9-10 say about Christ as our Savior?
- 6) On Sunday, we looked at being saved from the 1) Penalty of Sin 2) Power of Sin 3) Problem of Sin.
 - A) How are those three different, how are those three connected?
 - B) Can you think of a Bible verse or Bible story that describes being saved from the penalty of sin?
 - C) Can you think of a Bible verse or Bible story that describes being saved from the power of sin?
 - D) Can you think of a Bible verse or Bible story that addresses being saved from the problem of sin?
- 7) Imagine you’re talking to someone who doesn’t recognize their need for a Savior. What could you say or do that might influence them towards Jesus?

- 2) How can that change how you live this week?
