Digging Deeper

- 1) Our topic this week is Christ's being obedient unto death. Even in the face of the greatest sacrifice, Jesus didn't turn from the path God had for Him. What does Mark 14:32-36 show us about Christ's perspective as He faced death?
- 2) Mark 15:29-32 describes what people were saying to Jesus while He hung on the cross.
 - a) What stands out to you from their comments?
 - b) Why didn't Christ save Himself?
- 3) 1 Peter 2:23-25 describes Christ's response to suffering. What can we learn from these verses?
- 4) Take a moment and read Hebrews 12:1-4.
 - a) According to this verse, what did Jesus do?
 - b) According to this verse, what are we called to do?
 - c) How can this verse encourage us to be thankful to Christ?
 - d) How can this verse encourage us to continue in obedience?
- 5) Take a moment to read Philippians 2:5-10.
 - a) Philippians 2:7 states that Christ "emptied himself". In what way did Christ empty Himself?
 - b) Philippians 2:8 uses the word "humbled". How are humility and obedience connected?
 - c) The passage starts by stating that Christ is God, then it shows Him lowering Himself by becoming man, and then lowering Himself to death on a cross. Where do verse 9 show Christ?
 - d) According to verses 9 and 10, what will everyone do?
- 6) Do you have any other questions or comments from this week's study?
